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## Viewing & Using the Dashboard on the Home tab [GPv3]

The dashboard will display the current state of all active devices.

1. If all devices are in a Normal state, "**All OK**" will be displayed.



2. If any of the devices are in a state which is not the Normal state, the appropriate state will be displayed.

i.e. **Emergency, Overdue, Pending Check-In, Pending Location Request, Monitored Devices** etc.



3. Selecting any of the entries from the dashboard will filter devices which are in the selected state on the map.

In the example below, **Emergency** was selected from the Dashboard.
